

by an agent as by the principal, such requirement shall be construed to include all such acts performed by an authorized agent. (Ord. 1319 §6, 1980).

1.04.060 Prohibited acts include causing and permitting. Whenever in the ordinances of the city of Kettle Falls, any act or omission is made unlawful, it shall include causing, allowing, permitting, abetting, suffering, or concealing the fact of such act or omission. (Ord. 1319 §7, 1980).

1.04.070 Computation of time. Except when otherwise provided, the time within which an act is required to be done shall be computed by excluding the first day and including the last day, unless the last day is Sunday or a holiday, in which case it shall also be excluded. (Ord. 1319 §8, 1980).

1.04.080 Construction. The provisions of the ordinances of the city of Kettle Falls and all proceedings under them are to be construed with a view to effect their objects and to promote justice. (Ord. 1319 §9, 1980).

1.04.090 Repeal shall not revive any ordinances. The repeal of an ordinance shall not repeal the repealing clause of an ordinance or revive any ordinance which has been repealed thereby. (Ord. 1319 §10, 1980).

Chapter 1.06

CITY CLASSIFICATION

Sections:

1.06.010 Classification adopted. The city of Kettle Falls adopts the classification of noncharter code city as provided for in RCW Ch. 35A.02 and such classification as noncharter code city shall become effective in all respects under the mayor-council plan upon reading and passage of the ordinance codified in this chapter. (Ord. 1314 §2, 1979).

1.06.020 Succession of city officers. The city council members and mayor shall continue to hold office for the balance of the terms for which they were elected, and that upon expiration of said terms, their successors are to be

elected and qualified at the next biennial municipal election to be conducted as provided in RCW 35A.29, that the office of council members for positions 4 and 5 will be filled at the 1979 general municipal election for a four-year term of office and the city council member position numbers 1, 2, 3, shall be filled at the 1981 general municipal election for a four-year term of office. (Ord. 1314, §3, 1979).

1.06.030 Notification to state. The clerk-treasurer of the city is authorized and directed to forward to the Secretary of State, Olympia, Washington, a certified copy of the ordinance codified in this chapter adopting the classification of noncharter code city, together with a certified copy of the published resolution providing for the change to noncharter code city. (Ord. 1314, §4, 1979).

Chapter 1.08

GENERAL PENALTY

Sections:

- 1.08.010 General Penalty.
- 1.08.020 Continuing Offenses.

1.08.010 General Penalty. Any person violating any of the provisions or failing to comply with any of the mandatory requirements of the ordinances of the city of Kettle Falls shall be guilty of a misdemeanor unless the violation is a gross misdemeanor by ordinance. Except where a different punishment is prescribed by ordinance, the punishment for a misdemeanor shall be a fine not to exceed \$1,000.00, imprisonment not exceeding 90 days, or both, and the punishment for a gross misdemeanor shall be a fine not exceeding \$5,000.00 and imprisonment not exceeding one (1) year, or both.

1.08.020 Continuing Offenses. Each person is guilty of a separate offense for each and every day during any portion of which any violation of any provision of the ordinances of Kettle Falls is committed, continued, or permitted by any such person, and is punishable accordingly.
