10.04.010 Purpose. The purpose of this chapter is to adopt the Washington Model Traffic Statutes to regulate traffic upon the public streets and ways within the city limits of the city of Kettle Falls and repealing all ordinances and sections of ordinances in conflict therewith. (Ord. 1342, §1, 1980).

10.04.020 Adoption by reference. The Washington Model Traffic Ordinance, Chapter 308 - 330 WAC, is hereby adopted by reference as the traffic ordinance of the city of Kettle Falls as if set forth fully herein. (Ord. 1564 §4, 1998; Ord. 1516, §1, 1994).

10.04.030 Repeal. City of Kettle Falls Ordinance No. 1342 and all ordinances and parts of any ordinances in conflict with the model traffic ordinance are hereby repealed. (Ord. 1516, §2, 1994).

10.04.040 Savings clause. The repeal of Ordinance No. 1342 does not affect any pending or existing litigation and does not operate as an abatement or bar to any action or proceeding pending under or by virtue of the repealed ordinance. (Ord. 1516, §3, 1994).

10.04.050 Railroad trains. A. It is unlawful for the directing officer or the operator of any railroad train to direct the operation of or to operate the same in such a manner as to prevent the use of any street for purposes of travel for a period of time longer than five minutes, except that this provision shall not apply to trains or cars in motion other than those engaged in switching.

10.04.060 Violation - Penalty. Violation or failure to comply with any of the provisions of Section 10.04.020 and conviction thereof shall subject the offender to a fine not exceeding two hundred fifty dollars, except that for RCW Sections 10.31.100 and 46.63.020 (1 through 33) the penalty provisions of the RCW shall apply. (Ord. 1346, §2 (part), 1980: Ord. 1342, §4, 1978).

10.04.070 Severability clause. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance, or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected. (Ord. 1516, §4, 1994).
