

contained in this chapter shall be held to prohibit any sale required by statute or by order of any court or to prevent any person conducting a bona fide auction sale pursuant to law. Garage sales shall be exempt from the terms of this chapter. (Ord. 1330 §8, 1980).

5.08.090 Violation--Penalty. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of a petty misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not exceeding one hundred dollars. Each and every person is guilty of a separate offense for each and every day during any portion of which any violation of any provision of the ordinances of Kettle Falls is committed, continued, or permitted by any such person, and he shall be punished accordingly. (Ord. 1330 §9, 1980).

5.08.100 Nonliability of city. This chapter is intended to be a law of general application for the public at large; it is not intended to impose liability on the part of the city or its employees running to individual members of the public. (Ord. 1330 §10, 1980).

## Chapter 5.12

### PUBLIC DANCES

#### Sections:

- 5.12.020 Sundays.

5.12.010 Hours. It is unlawful for any person, firm, association or corporation within the corporate limits of the city to conduct any public dance or other type of public entertainment to which the general public is invited or admitted, between the hours of one a.m. and six a.m. of any day; provided, however, that such public dance or entertainment may be conducted at such time if a written permit for same has previously been granted by the city. (Ord. 1137 1/2 §1, 1947).

5.12.020 Sundays. It is unlawful for any person, firm, society, corporation or association within the corporate limits of the city to conduct any public dance to which the general public is invited, or admitted, between the hours of one a.m. and twelve p.m., midnight, Sunday. (Ord. 1147 §1, 1951).
