

CHAPTER 8.14PROVISIONS FOR HAWKERS, PEDDLERS AND SOLICITORSSections:

8.14.010 Purpose. The purpose of this chapter is to adopt by reference those portions of RCW 49.12, RCW 36.71, and RCW 48.17.

8.14.020 Unlawful to go to private residents as a solicitor, hawker, itinerant merchant or transient vendor. It is unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to go to private residences within the City of Kettle Falls as a solicitor, hawker, itinerant merchant or transient vendor, when not having been requested or invited to do so in advance by the owner or owners, occupant or occupants of the private residence, for the purposes of soliciting orders for sales of goods, wares and merchandises and for the purpose of bartering or hawking the same.

8.14.030 Violation - Penalty. Any violation of this chapter shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars or by imprisonment in the county jail for a period not to exceed thirty days or by both such fine and imprisonment, and in addition the court may order that further action shall be enjoined by a permanent injunction.

8.16.010 Purpose. The City Council finds that inadequately controlled noise affects the health, safety, and welfare of the people, the value of property, and the quality of the environment. There is a need to abate and control noise, considering the social and economic impact upon the city. This chapter provides for noise abatement, a method of enforcement and for adopting State Noise WAC's by reference.
