RESOLUTION NO. 09-02

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PERMITTING PROCESS FOR PAVING OF PRIVATE DRIVEWAYS EXTENDING ONTO CITY STREETS.

WHEREAS, The City of Kettle Falls is responsible for maintaining city streets and right-of-ways, including snow removal and provisions for adequate drainage; and

WHEREAS, The paving of private driveways by residents can potentially interfere with drainage and other maintenance activities on the public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, The Council of the City of Kettle Falls deems it necessary that procedures be established to adequately manage public right-of-ways; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED The Council of the City of Kettle Falls hereby moves to establish requirements for paving permits for private driveways on public right-of-ways, using established building permit application and enforcement procedures, and subject to design approval and final inspection by the City Superintendent; and, further,

BE IT RESOLVED That the permit fee for such paving will be \$20.00 (twenty dollars).




